ADDENDUM #1

Please note for purposes of quote, the following clarifications:

- Halifax 2011 Canada Games Host Society ('Halifax 2011') is responsible for all levelling and site preparation. We need to know from proponents what type of material the sub-base needs to be for installation.
- 'Halifax 2011' is responsible for all trenches to be dug for piping mains, as well as repair of said trenches.
- 'Halifax 2011' is responsible for fencing the area to prevent vandalism to the pipe prior to ice being made for Jan. 1 , 2011
- Once the pipe is in place and covered by sand 'Halifax 2011' will provide plastic coverings (tarps) to prevent the sand being washed away should there be a heavy rainfall.
- 'Halifax 2011' will be responsible for placing a curb around the inside and outside perimeter to keep sand in place, if it is required.
- 'Halifax 2011' is responsible for providing power for the refrigeration units.
- 'Halifax 2011' is responsible for providing water for the evaporative condensers.
- Please include in your timeline when site access is required.
- Decommissioning refers to all items that make-up the refrigeration system.

- Plans for HRM to run the Oval for residents after the games are complete are not being addressed at this time.
- Estimated decommissioning will be April 2011. Final destination of packages is to be decided and is not included in this RFP.
